

Future Founder Challenge 2025: Rules & Regulations for Participation

Participation Criteria

- Open to high school students (Grades 9–12).
- Teams must comprise 2–3 students. Multiple Teams can be nominated
- Each team must have a project name and business idea at the time of nomination.
- 01 School faculty to accompany their student teams if team is selected in Finale.
- 100% attendance in all online workshops is mandatory for all shortlisted teams after nominations.

Presentation Rules (Finale at UPES)

- Selected teams for the final must mandatorily submit their pitch deck at least 5 days before the event.
- Any other required materials (e.g., product prototypes) should be brought by the selected teams at their own expense and liability.
- Judges will select the winning teams based on the Judging Criteria prescribed hereinafter.
- Final pitch duration: 5 minutes with 3-minute Q&A by judges.
- Broad Judging Criteria:
 - Creativity and Innovation
 - Business Viability and Feasibility
 - Presentation Quality and Communication
 - Teamwork and Collaboration
 - Responsiveness to Questions

Dress Code for Finale

- Formal attire required – school uniforms are not allowed.
- Boys: Formal shirt and trousers with closed-toe shoes.
- Girls: Formal shirt/trousers/skirt or equivalent formal attire.

Code of Conduct

- Maintain discipline and punctuality at all times at Campus.
- Respect judges, mentors, and fellow participants.
- Unruly behavior may lead to disqualification.

Awards & Prizes

- Main Awards:
 - National Level: Best Startup Team (Winner) and 1st Runner-up
 - Zonal Level: Best Startup Team (Winner) and 1st Runner-up in each zone
- Special Awards {Certificates & Mementos}
 - Best CEO
 - Best COO
 - Best CFO
 - Best CMO
 - Best Presentation
 - Best Prototype
 - Best Technology Idea
 - Best Sustainability Idea
- Travel to and from UPES Campus for finale to be arranged by Self (students)/Participating Schools
