1. Introduction

UPES provides dedicated on-campus health support through one Medical Health Centre at each of its Bidholi and Kandoli campuses. The supplied institutional document records round-the-clock 24×7 medical services, day-care facilities, medical personnel, emergency equipment, medicines and life-saving drugs, BLS ambulances, preventive-health activities, training, medical coverage for campus activities, referral services and biomedical-waste management.

The health-support system combines curative, preventive and emergency-care functions to support students and staff and to facilitate referral to nearby hospitals when required.

The supplied document records a total of 4 Doctors, including one Resident Doctor at each campus, and 6 Nursing Assistants and Pharmacists. It further specifies male and female residential Nursing Assistants at each campus.

10. Biomedical Waste Management & Sanitary Health

Biomedical waste management is carried out as per authorization of the Uttarakhand Pollution Control Board. The supplied evidence also shows biomedical-waste segregation arrangements at Bidholi and a preventive-health sanitary round at the food court.

11. Referral & Medical Insurance Support

Referral services are provided to nearby hospitals. The supplied document states that medical insurance cover is available for both staff and students, supporting continuity of care beyond the on-campus facilities.

12. Medical Support for Campus Activities

Based on the supplied UPES Health Support Services document, the university has established a structured health-support system across Bidholi and Kandoli. The system integrates dedicated Medical Health Centres, day-care capacity, medical and nursing/pharmacy personnel, emergency equipment, medicines, BLS ambulances, preventive-health programmes, training, activity coverage, referral services and biomedical-waste management.
